SCHEDULE OF BORROWING SUPPLEMENTARY READING MATERIALS (SRM) OF SOUTH CLUSTER AND SCHEDULE OF STORYTELLING SESSIONS IN ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

1. Pursuant to the Deped's banner program, "Every Child A Reader Program (ECARP)", the District of Mendez Library Hub has set its schedule for borrowing of supplementary reading materials (SRM) to South Cluster public elementary and secondary schools:

- 2. The Public School District Supervisors will coordinate with the School Heads, elementary and secondary learning resource managers (teacher librarians) in planning the scheme for the utilization of SRMs in all the schools in the district within the duration of 25 days. Proper recording of the turn over of SRMs from one school to another must be properly observed to avoid losses.
- 3. The School Heads must ensure proper recording and care of SRMs. The classroom teacher concerned shall be held responsible and accountable for the reading materials taken out and not returned within the prescribed period. In case of lost or unreturned books or materials, replacements of the same book title and author shall be implemented.
- 4. Supplementary Reading Materials (SRMs) should be used in the classroom for integration in the lessons.
- 5. Elementary/ Secondary school heads and the learning resource managers should submit a brief report on how these materials were used in your school/district posting activities in the facebook page: depedcavite.lrmd@gmail.com.
- 6. Returning of books in the Division Library Hub from East, North and West Clusters will be every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday while borrowers from South Cluster may return books at Mendez Library Hub every Tuesday and Thursday only.
