SPECIAL CONSIDERATION TO LEARNERS' ACTIVE PARTICIPATION AND EXEMPLARY PERFORMANCE TO CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

To: Schools Division Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools
All Others Concerned

- 1. The Department of Education (DepEd) Region IV A CALABARZON mandates all Schools Division Superintendents, more specifically the School Heads and Subject Teachers to provide Special Consideration to Learners' Active Participation and Exemplary Performance to Co-curricular Activities.
- 2. Learners' active participation and exemplary performance to co-curricular activities bring honor and prestige to the entire region, thus providing them special consideration on the exams and/or graded activities that the learners would possibly be missing in connection with their attendance/active participation and exemplary performance to co-curricular activities is but appropriate and lawful.
- 3. These special considerations include the following: by allowing learners to be officially excused in the class, by providing learners reasonable time to make up for examinations and classes missed through modules and/or any of the most appropriate form of alternative assessments aligned to the required target competencies, by giving learners grades which they have gained after the appropriate examinations or alternative assessments were given; by giving learners points for their co-curricular exemplary performance based on D.O. no. 74, s. 2012 though they are not candidates for honors; and by informing and involving all concerned, learner's parents and subject teachers, regarding this matter.
- 4. Effective School Year (SY) 2015-2016, this policy in providing Special Consideration to Learners' Active Participation and Exemplary Performance to Co-curricular Activities shall be implemented in elementary and secondary schools region-wide.
