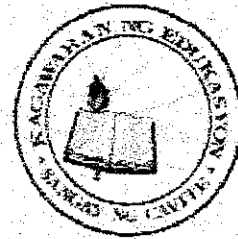






C. Contest Reference of the Taskforce /Guidelines for the Flow of Contest Categories

1. All contest rules/policies and guidelines should adhere/follow **Regional Memorandum on 2015 Regional Science and Technology Fair and Congress.**
2. The decision of the board of judges is final.
3. Committee in charge prepares the registration list by category, contestant number, tally sheet and validates contest results.
4. Time allotment for all categories should be strictly followed.
5. The task force for the preliminary phase will be the same tasks force during the final phase.
6. All contestants should be in school uniform wearing their respective school ID.

Science Quiz

1. Contest Chair by Grade level consolidates the test questions received from the Science Unit Chairman
2. Test committee members prepare the seat plan and strictly monitor the conduct of the test. No calculators and cellphones are allowed inside the testing rooms. Retrieve and return test materials to the document secretariat immediately after the examination.
3. Quiz contestants should bring yellow pads for their answer sheets.
4. One hour is allotted for the written phase.
5. Only Top Ten from the written phase will be included in the oral phase to answer Easy, average, difficult questions, For tie scores, five clincher questions will be given.
6. Chaperons and coaches are not allowed to enter the testing rooms.
7. Only the Contestants are allowed to verify/give queries before the reading of the next question. Questions for the previous numbers will no longer be entertained after the succeeding quiz items had been read.
8. Only top 10 scorers in the written phase are qualified for the oral phase.
9. Only written phase will be administered for teachers' category.

Science Investigatory Projects

1. Hardcopies of the SIP will be consolidated by categories two days before the contest at the office of the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) Division Office.
2. The three boards of judges conduct the preliminary judging identifying top 5 for the science congress- oral defense.
3. Tasks force prepares the tally and consolidation sheet based from the Regional memorandum on 2015 RSTFC.
4. All final results from the oral phase are to be submitted to the document secretariat.

Report on the conduct of the 2015 DSTFC shall be prepared by the Document Secretariat after the closing program for submission to the Regional Office.
