We are pleased to announce that the Philosophy Department of the University of Asia and the Pacific (UA&P) will hold a seminar-workshop entitled Teaching Philosophy of the Human Person and Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao in the K to 12 Curriculum, scheduled for Wednesday to Friday, April 6 to 8 2016, at the Telengtan Hall, University of Asia and the Pacific, Pearl Drive, Ortigas Center. This seminar is the first of a series of teacher training seminar-workshop which will be held every April starting 2016 till 2018.

1. To develop correct and deeper understanding of the basic concepts relevant to the subjects of Introduction to the Philosophy of the Human Person and Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao. This will render a more substantial and

To demonstrate some of the best practices in teaching approaches and assessment tools used in these subjects.

To illustrate how the learners can use critical thinking and moral reasoning and practice virtuous behavior.

The seminar will run for three days. Each day will focus on a specific module which will have two parts. Part I is the theoretical part and Part II is the practical part. The theoretical part will elaborate on the basic concepts. The practical part will cover the best practices in teaching the basic concepts. There will be a workshop each day focused on a concrete topic related to the module for that day. The workshop will explore ways to best present the topic to a particular grade level, make a lesson plan, demonstrate how to deliver the topic and get feedback from the other participants.

The target participants are teachers of Introduction to the Philosophy of the Human Person and teachers of Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (Grades 7-10) from public and private secondary schools. The roster of resource persons comprises faculty members of the Philosophy Department of the College of Arts and Sciences of the University of Asia & the Pacific, all specialists in their respective fields of study. We enclose the plan of the seminar workshop for your perusal. The conference-workshop fee is three thousand five hundred pesos, (PHP 3,500) to cover lunch and snacks, materials, and other incidental expenses for the three-day activity. Early bird registration is PHP 3,200.


