ANNUAL PHYSICAL EXAMINATION TEACHING & NON-TEACHING PERSONNEL (Chest X-Ray/Urinalysis)

- 1. Tuberculosis remains the Top 10 causes of deaths in the Philippines. Tuberculosis: Still one of the deadliest treatable diseases in the Philippines. Philippine National Tuberculosis Prevalence Survey reveals that there are approximately three tuberculosis cases in 1000 Filipinos.
- 2. The prevention and control of Tuberculosis among School personnel is one of the health program of our Department. The conduct of Annual Physical Examination of Teaching and Non-Teaching Personnel Annual Chest X-Ray & Urinalysis helps us gather data, case finding and early detection of cases.
- 3. Conformably to the DepEd Memo No.44 s.2004 and Division Memo No. 20 s. 2015, that the School Health Section shall continue the implementation on the Prevention and Control of Tuberculosis and other preventable diseases among school populace.
- 4. Based on the division data of 2014 we have 31 confirmed PTB cases and 22 confirmed PTB cases last 2015 that were refer to DOTS facilities for proper evaluation and treatment. The School Health Section ensures the confidentiality of each case.
- 5. To accomplish this objective, all public and private elementary and secondary teaching and non-teaching personnel to undergo: Chest X-Ray and Urinalysis. You may avail of the services of MARY IMMACULATE mobile laboratory. This cost P150.00 per head (Chest X-Ray and Urinalysis).

- 6. School administrator are enjoined to give full administrative support to this program by:
 - Encouraging their personnel to undergo Chest X-Ray and Urinalysis.
 - Intensifying TB prevention and control in schools.
 - Principals should encourage to complete attendance of their personnel during the annual physical examination.
- 7. Administrator of private schools may initiate the tuberculosis prevention and control program in their respective areas.
- 8. The Public Health Nurses in charge of their districts are requested to report on a regular basis this summer in order to ensure the full implementation of the programs.
- 9. FOOD HANDLERS are requested to submit their Chest X-Ray, Urinalysis and stool exam and secure a certification from the Municipal Health Office.
- 10. Personnel with positive result in Chest X-Ray (Tuberculosis) will be subjected to Directed Sputum Smear examination to determine the activity of illness prior to treatment.
- 10. District Supervisors, Elementary and Secondary Public School Principals, TIC/Head Teachers are requested to submit in this office the summary of /Chest X-Ray result using the TB Form I (Consolidated Accomplishment Report) and Form III (Master list) as soon as the result becomes available.
- 11. Enclosed is the scheduled of Chest X-Ray/Urinalysis in the different districts.
- 12. For immediate dissemination and compliance.
