**MASS TRAINING OF GRADE 5 TEACHERS ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF K-12 BASIC EDUCATION CURRICULUM (PHASE 2)**

1. In line with the continuing implementation of K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum, this Office will hold the Mass Training of Grade 5 Teachers on the Implementation of K-12 Basic Education Curriculum (Phase 2) in different venues from May 31-June 3, 2016. Registration starts at 7:00 a.m. of Day 1.
2. This second phase of the Mass Training aims to enable the Grade 5 teachers to:
  - a. demonstrate an in-depth understanding of the content of each learning area;
  - b. identify appropriate techniques and strategies for specific learning content;
  - c. contextualize learning contents; and
  - d. conduct demonstration teaching on their area of specialization.
3. Participants to this live-out training are all Grade 5 teachers in English, Science, Mathematics, Filipino, Araling Panlipunan (AP), Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP), Edukasyong Pantahanan at Pangkabuhayan (EPP) and Music, Arts, Physical Education and Health (MAPEH) who attended the Phase 1 training at Tanza Oasis Hotel on April 17-22, 2016 (Batch 1) and April 24-29 (Batch 2). They are entitled to service credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 otherwise known as the Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers.
4. Participants are advised to bring their own provision for food. They are also required to bring their government-issued tablets/laptops, printed copy of Curriculum Guide, and reference materials/books.
