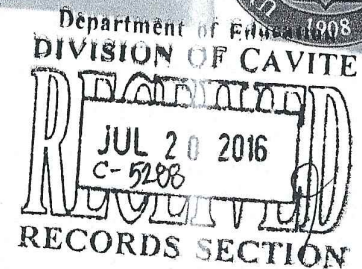

I. Activity Title: Kabataang Kabitenyo Day 2016: Indigenous People in the Modern Philippines

II. Target Participants: Grade 7-11 students in Cavite

III. Target Date and Venue: October 22, 2016 at TBA

IV. Rationale

Cavite is a province sometimes mistaken as an entirely urban place due to its proximity to Manila and at the same time thought to be as a very rural place maybe because of its history. Cavite is neither of these two ; rather, it is a perfect combination of rural and urban. What its urban part lacks, the rural fills and vice versa. All this makes a province that is rich in history and culture but still gets on with the times.

As Caviteños, the youth must be mindful and more active participants in the province's activities. Not only to voice out inside the four walls of the classroom, but also to empower themselves as primary supporters of the province's several advocacies outside the school. The youth, as young as they may, have the capacity to be agents of dynamism in the community. This year's Kabataang Kabitenyo Day, with the main theme revolving around indigenous peoples in the Philippines, aims to equip the youth the correct facts regarding the IPs in the Philippines now in order to acknowledge and support them.

Aside from the prized historical places, Cavite is also known for its heroes who led the country to victory over Spain in the 16th century. Even then, Caviteños have showed a sign for leadership, making things happen, and being successful in many aspects of life. The Alyansa ng mga Kabitenyo sa UPLB (ANAK-UPLB), the official varsitarian organization of Caviteño students in the University of the Philippines – Los Banos, believes that Caviteño youth has the characteristics and the capability to continue this legacy of active participation as well as to encourage other members of the community to do the same.

V. Objectives

Kabataang Kabitenyo Day aims to provide a venue where the Caviteño youth can express their pride in being a Caviteño and their opinions on social issues concerning our province and the country as a whole. This will help them express their appreciation of our province through the various forms of media, as well as to be aware of their abilities as students to encourage other people to realize the same.

Generally, the KKD aims to:

1. express why a Caviteño youth should be proud of his/her love for his/her own province through an essay writing contest;
2. interpret what a Caviteño youth is doing to show his/her support in promoting his/her province through a poster making contest; and
3. recognize how a Caviteño youth can preserve and pass the sense of love and appreciation of his/her province to the next generations through an extemporaneous speech contest.

Specifically, the KKD this year aims to:

1. promote awareness of the different indigenous peoples residing in the Philippines;
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2. inform the youth of the different issues indigenous people in the Philippines are currently facing; and
3. encourage the youth to support the indigenous peoples in the Philippines.

VI. Qualifications, Application, Registration, and Mechanics

A. Qualifications

Students from private and public high schools within Cavite are qualified to join. One (1) student per school is allowed to join for each event. The school should have a different set of participants for each contest.

B. Application

Email duly accomplished forms on or before September 30, 2016 at anakuplb@gmail.com.

Those schools who wish to participate but were not able to submit their application forms on the stated date above can register at the actual day of the event but will only be allowed to join upon the approval of the Event Committee.

C. Registration

Registration will start at 8:00 am on October 22, 2016. The location will be announced at least a month before the event. The registration fee per school will be Php 150.00 for the essay writing contest, Php 150.00 for the poster making contest and Php 150.00 for the extemporaneous speech contest.

D. Mechanics

1. Essay Writing Contest

- a. Only one (1) contestant from each participating school shall be allowed to join.
- b. The contest shall be held on October 22, 2016. The time and location shall be announced beforehand. The specific theme to be given on the contest proper shall revolve around the theme of the event "2016: Indigenous People in the Modern Philippines".
- c. The participant should bring proper identification materials (i.e. school ID and the registration form).
- d. The participant must be present ten minutes before the event. Otherwise, s/he shall not be allowed to participate.
- e. The essay shall be judged according to the content, originality, structure and style.

The percentage of the criteria is as follows:

Content	40%
Originality	20%
Structure	20%

Style	20%
Total	100%

- f. All essays shall strictly be written in **Filipino**.
- g. Any form of cheating is prohibited. Any participant caught cheating shall be automatically disqualified.
- h. The top three essays shall be chosen. Winners shall be awarded with medals and certificates. All participants shall be awarded certificates of participation.
- i. Winners shall be announced during the awarding ceremony on the same day.
- j. All essays shall automatically become official properties of the organization.

2. Poster-Making Contest

- a. At most two (2) contestants working individually from each participating school shall be allowed to join.
- b. The contest shall be held on October 22, 2016. The time and location shall be announced beforehand. The specific theme to be given on the contest proper shall revolve around the theme of the event "2016: Indigenous People in the Modern Philippines".
- c. Only the materials below shall be used for the contest.
 - i. ¼ illustration board and one (1) Mongol \No. 2 pencil (to be provided by the organization)
 - ii. coloring material (to be provided by the contestant)
- d. The participant should bring proper identification materials. (i.e. school ID and the registration form)
- e. The participant must be present ten minutes before the event. Otherwise, s/he shall not automatically be allowed to join.
- f. The posters shall be judged according to the content, originality, and overall impact.

The percentage of the criteria is as follows:

Content	50%
Originality	30%
Overall impact	20%
Total:	100%

- g. The top three posters shall be chosen. Winners shall be awarded with medals and certificates. All participants shall be awarded certificates of participation.
- h. The use of other materials not specified above is strictly prohibited. Participants caught using prohibited materials shall be disqualified.
- i. Winners shall be announced during the awarding ceremony on the same day.
- j. All posters shall be displayed for the whole duration of the event.
- k. The posters shall automatically become official properties of the organization.

3. Extemporaneous Speech Contest

- a. Only one (1) contestant from each participating school shall be allowed to join.
- b. The contest shall be held on October 22, 2016. The time and location shall be announced beforehand. The specific theme to be given on the contest proper shall revolve around the theme of the event "2016: Indigenous People in the Modern Philippines".
- c. The participant should bring proper identification materials (i.e. school ID and the registration form).

- d. The participant must be present ten minutes before the event. Otherwise, s/he shall not be allowed to join.
- e. Each participant shall be given three minutes to prepare and another three minutes to speak.
- f. The speech shall be delivered in **Filipino**.
- g. The speeches shall be judged according to the content, delivery and impact. The percentage of the criteria is as follows:

Content	50%
Delivery	30%
<u>Impact</u>	<u>20%</u>
Total	100%
- h. Deductions shall be given for those who exceed in the allotted time.
- i. The top three speeches shall be chosen. Winners shall be awarded with medals and certificates. All participants shall be awarded certificates of participation.
- j. Winners shall be announced during the awarding ceremony on the same day.
