2016 DIVISION TRAINING IN JOURNALISM FOR PRIVATE SCHOOLS

1. Pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 7079, otherwise known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991, the Division Educational Media Work Plan for 2016. DepEd Cavite, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will hold the 2016 DIVISION TRAINING IN JOURNALISM FOR PRIVATE SCHOOLS for the ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY LEVEL on September 1-3, 2016 at Colegio de Sta Rosa, Brgy Conchu, Trece Martires City, Cavite, respectively for the Individual Writing Contests. In addition, the Collaborative Desktop Publishing and the Radio Scriptwriting and Broadcasting contests will be held at the same venue and dates.

2. The conduct of the activity is led by the CAVITE ALLIANCE OF PRIVATE SCHOOLS (CAPS) with the cooperation of DCPAPSA, ASEP, MLSP, FCS and BRAIN CHALLENGE.

3. The training aims to:

- A. Highlight the importance of journalism in the development of the learners' 21st century Skills
- B. Sustain advocacy on social consciousness
- C. Promote responsible journalism and fair and ethical use of social media
- D. Hone the Journalistic skills of the students.

4. The training activities shall include the following:

- I. Individual Training and Contests
 - A. News Writing
 - B. Editorial Writing
 - C. Feature Writing
 - D. Copy Reading and Headline Writing
 - E. Sports Writing
 - F. Editorial Cartooning
 - G. Photojournalism
 - H. Science and Health Writing
- II. Group Training and Contests
 - A. Script Writing and Radio Broadcasting
 - B. Collaborative Publishing

5. All student/pupil delegates and teacher-advisers from private schools with existing school papers are required to participate in the 2016 DIVISION TRAINING IN JOURNALISM FOR PRIVATE SCHOOLS before they can join the DSPC.

6. Each student/pupil delegate must bring one (1) 1x1 latest photo to be pasted on the 2016

DIVISION TRAINING IN JOURNALISM FOR PRIVATE SCHOOLS ID.

7. For the smooth conduct of the registration of participants, all participating schools are required to pre-register on or before August 26, 2016 through the following Registration Committee members:

8. Registration should be supported by four(4) copies of accomplished Registration/Entry Form signed by the principal of each school (see Enclosure No. 2)

A registration fee of Three Hundred Pesos (P300.00) will be charged to each delegate (student/pupil and teacher-adviser) to cover expenses for honoraria of resource speakers, IDs, certificates, medals, plaques, operational expenses during the DIVISION TRAINING IN JOURNALISM FOR PRIVATE SCHOOLS .

10. An annual membership fee of twenty pesos(P20.00) for each teacher -adviser and ten pesos (P10.00) for each student-delegate will likewise be paid.

11. Registration and transportation fees of participants relative to their attendance in the said training shall be charged against local funds,MOOE or school paper funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

12. Participants shall make necessary arrangements with their institutions in connection to their participation to the contests.

13. Each delegate must bring his/her own provision for food.

14. It is reiterated that students joining the district and higher level competitions in journalism be given the rightful, valid and planned considerations in their academic written requirements and performances.

GUIDELINES FOR THE CONTESTS

1. The top ten(10) for each category-English and Filipino both Elementary and Secondary levels are qualified to participate in the DSPC.
2. A student shall be allowed to participate in only one (1) category. Participation in the individual writing contests shall be limited only to those enrolled in the six-year elementary ,four-year Junior High School and Senior High School.
3. In the photojournalism contest, each contestant is expected to:
 - A. Bring/use any digital camera (point and shoot only) with a maximum of 16 mega pixels(DLSR and High end cameras are NOT allowed).
 - B. Have his own camera cable for the uploading of pictures.
 - C. Avoid bringing cellular phones, extra digital cameras, extra storage card and any material/equipment in the contest area.
4. In collaborative publishing, these guidelines should be followed:
 - A. A team of seven (7) members for both elementary and secondary levels (one (1) for English, one (1) for Filipino) shall be organized who shall not compete in any of the individual contests.
 - B. Each team is required to bring a maximum of four (4) laptops installed with Adobe In-Design and Photoshop for Secondary, and Microsoft Publisher for the elementary.
5. IDs should be worn ALL THE TIME by all contestants and teacher-advisers during the three day training.
6. All contestants must be in their school uniform with the School ID's worn with the 2016 DIVISION TRAINING IN JOURNALISM FOR PRIVATE SCHOOLS IDs.
