

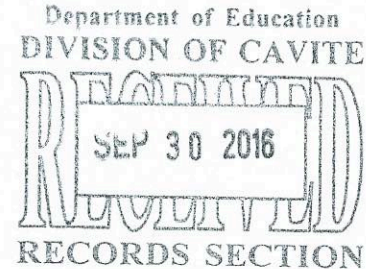

May we request all the participants to submit parent's consent and health examination form on or before October 4, 2016. Please contact us at the telephone number (046) 435-7283.



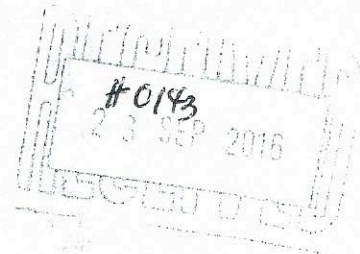

Participants: At least 1 Patrol of Senior Girl Scouts (must be physically fit, earned at least one badge each under the 8-point challenge and must have attended a troop/school camp/councilwide encampment). Chief Girl Scout applicants without regional event yet are requested to participate.

Registration Fee: P 2,800.00/camper for Food, Program materials, bag & T-shirt, entrance fee to EK and transportation (Los Baños-Sta. Rosa-Los Baños)

Please be reminded that councils should organize the participants into a patrol especially if the girls come from different schools/districts in their pre-camp to facilitate all the activities and exercise the patrol system for the whole duration of the encampment.

Each patrol will be given food provision that they will cook in all the meals.

All camping equipment, gadget woods and others should be in sack or bags with label. All councils will be provided with charcoal stove and charcoal.

Further, please submit the attached reply slip, parent's consent and health examination form on or before *October 4*, 2016.
