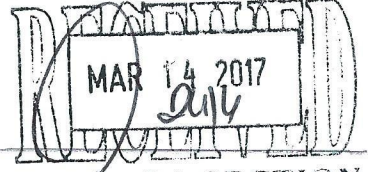

**2017 CULTURAL CENTER OF THE PHILIPPINES SUMMER ARTS ACADEMY**

1. In support of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP) and the Department of Education (DepEd), which was signed on September 23, 2016, "... to collaboratively undertake trainings and other relevant activities for the K to 12 Program" and "... to support the K to 12 Arts and Design Trainings and other relevant activities that CCP may undertake for the K to 12 programs through the issuance of memoranda..." the CCP, through its Arts Education Department will conduct series of workshops under the **2017 CCP Summer Arts Academy**, for teachers of Senior High School (SHS) Arts and Design Track and the Special Program in the Arts (SPA) from **April 4 to May 26, 2017** at the CCP and in selected workshop venues in the National Capital Region.

2. The **2017 CCP Summer Arts Academy** is specially designed to provide teachers (nonbeginners) with specialized training on their respective art forms, to build their capacities and advance their level of art literacy, production techniques and processes. Only 30 teachers shall participate per module.

3. Preference will be given to teacher-applicants who are actively engaged with creative, artistic and management production or activities or who are actively engaged in mentoring or coaching of students in the arts, for recent competitions such as National Music Competition for Young Artists (NAMCYA), National Festival of Talents (NFOT), and other national and international competitions or exhibits in the different art field.

4. The 2017 CCP Art Academy shall consist of workshops and training modules to be facilitated by artist-teachers and practitioners from the CCP Resident Companies and partners. The modules include the following:

This workshop introduces to the teachers how to prepare Philippine music lessons through lectures, research, and creating their own presentations.

	Ensemble Playing  By: Philippine Philharmonic Orchestra (PPO)  Venue: CCP	This workshop aims to teach the participants to develop their repertoire using the instruments of the orchestra. It also includes <i>module on technique</i> development.
	Classical Ballet Workshop for Teachers  By: Philippine Ballet Theater  Venue: CCP	This is a workshop on the <i>fundamental movement and</i> technique for advancement in classical dance.
May 23-27, 2017	Dance Composition/ Choreography  By: Ballet Philippines Ballet School	This workshop focuses on the processes and tools needed to compose and choreograph a dance.
	Narrative Film Editing  By: Lino Matalang Jr., CCP  Venue: CCP	Narrative Film Editing prepares the editor to act as collaborator, <i>storyteller, and clarifies and</i> sustains the viewers.
	Shadow Puppetry  By: Marco Cosico, PHSA  Venue: CCP	This is a workshop on an ancient <i>form of storytelling that uses</i> figures through translucent scrim or screen.

5. The CCP Arts Academy also includes the following trainings:
  - a. K to 12 Arts and Design Workshop in Silliman University from May 15 to 19, 2017; and
  - b. National Folk Dance Workshop by the Philippine Folk Dance Society from May 22 to 26, 2017 at Dumaguete City.

6. The participants must submit the following:
  - a. The completed application form as per enclosure;
  - b. Portfolio of the following for screening purposes:
    - i. Artistic works as director, choreographer, musical director, composer/arranger, visual artist, multi-media artist, shadow

puppeteer, film director, among others, either for school or community productions and artistic events, to be submitted:

1. in video mpeg4 or DVD format; or
  2. as an upload on youtube, among others, providing the URL address or corresponding link.
- ii. artistic work of students in the arts where teacher was mentor or coach for recent competitions such as NAMCYA, National Festival of Talents, and other recognized national or international competitions or exhibits in the different art fields, to be submitted:
    1. in video mpeg4 or DVD format; or
    2. as an upload to youtube, among others, providing the URL address or corresponding link.
  - c. List and contact number of artists and artist groups the teachers worked with, for reference purposes.
7. Deadline for submission of application and portfolio:

8. Notification of accepted applicants:

  - c. No walk-ins shall be allowed to register
9. Each accepted applicant shall be charged a registration fee of **Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P 3,500.00)** for workshop kits, training laboratory use and materials for the duration of the workshop for the participants.
- a. Registration, transportation, board and lodging and other expenses shall be charged to school MOOE/division/region Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations;

- c. Free registration shall be provided for a limited number of participants for winners of National and International competitions (NAMCYA, *Sayaw Pinoy*, NFOT, *Sinulog*, among others). Applicants who wish to avail of the *free registration* may be asked to further submit pertinent documents;
  - d. A discounted rate of Five Thousand Pesos (P 5,000.00) is available for those who wish to attend two workshops; and
  - e. Early birds approved by the CCP Screening Committee will only pay the registration fee of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P 2,500.00).

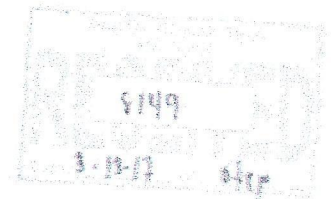
