- The Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) will hold the 61st Annual National Council Meeting (ANCM) from May 15 to 17, 2017 in Tagbilaran City, Bohol.
- 2. The ANCM sims to:
 - receive reports from the Kational President and the National Treasurer;
 - b. elect four regular members of the National Executive Board (NEB):
 - c. receive amendments to the BSP By-Laws; and
 - d. conduct the National Court of Honor.
- The Awarding Ceremonies of the Tribute to Scoutmaster, Outstanding Local Council and Regional Chairpersons, and Outstanding Local Council and Regional Commissioners are ancillary events.
- 4. The target participants are members of the NEB of the National Council composed of the following: (a) BSP NEB members; (b) Department of Education (DepEd) regional directors (RDs); (c) schools division superintendents (SDSs); (d) local council members, and (e) other local officials representing the 121 local councils of the BSP throughout the country.
- 5. The participants from DepEd are allowed to attend on official business. Travel expenses to be incurred by participating DepEd officials and teachers involved in scouting will be charged to local funds, subject to its availability, and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- The ROs and SDSs may attend the ANCM, provided that they shall receive the national higher awards and others, consistent with the BSP policy on personal acceptance of awards from the National Court of Honor. Relative to the conduct of the Grigada Eskuvia kick off program, caravan, and other activities as stated in DepEd Memorandum No. 43, s. 2017 entitled 2017 Brigada Eskuvila Implementing Guidelines. RDs and SDSs shall designate their assistant regional director, assistant schools division superintendent and other appropriate personnel to ensure the proper implementation of the Brigada Eskuvila. Since BSP is an important partner in youth development, other ROs and SDSs may send a representative in their capacity in the Regional Scouling Committees or Local Council Executive Boards.
