The Teachers' Dignity Coalition (TDC) will be holding the *National Seminar-Workshop on the Magna Carta for Public School Teachers, Public Sector Unionism and Human Rights Education: A Teachers' Summer Camp* on May 25-27, 2017 at Aringay Central Elementary School, Division of La Union. With the theme "Teachers' Rights and Responsibilities for Child-Friendly Schools" the seminar aims to deepen the understanding of teachers and school administrators on their rights and responsibilities and their role in promoting human rights.

The specific objectives of the seminar are:

- To equip the teacher-leaders and school heads with knowledge on Magna Carta for Public School Teachers and the public sector unionism
- To formulate policy recommendations on teachers' organizations
- To facilitate the formation of teachers' organizations in the grassroots
- To support the Department's mandate to teach human rights and popularize the rights-based approach in teaching

Teacher-leaders, school heads and other school personnel are invited to attend this activity which is being held in coordination with the Civil Service Commission and the Human Rights Commission. A minimum contribution of P1,500.00 shall be charged to each participant to cover cost of food, accommodation, kit, and other incidental expenses.

Registration at Aringay Central ES will start at 10:00AM of the 1st day, May 25, to be followed by the opening program at 2:00PM (provision for food will only start at 3:00PM for afternoon snacks). Closing ceremonies will be held at the nearby Paradise Beach Resort on the third day, May 27. Since the event is themed on a summer camp and schools in Aringay District will be used as billing areas, participants are advised to bring additional personal needs. Expenses for food and accommodation beyond those period shall be shouldered by the participants.

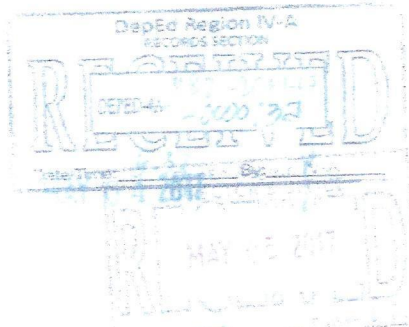
