

GENERAL GUIDELINES ON THE CONDUCT OF THE 2017 DIVISION TECHNOLYMPICS SKILLS COMPETITION

A. Participants

1. The participants of the 2017 Division Technolympics Skills Contest will showcase their best products and performances in the different events as an evidence of their learning in the different learning areas of specialization.
2. Participants are open to any learner who is currently enrolled in public or private secondary schools (Junior and Senior High Schools Grade 9 to 12) and public elementary schools (Grade 4 -6) for SY. 20172018.
3. A learner is allowed to participate in one (1) event/skill exhibition during the Division Festival of Talents (Technolympics).
4. The Secondary Principal/TLE/TVL Head Teacher for JHS / SHS and EPP Key Administrators per Municipality for Elementary shall submit the official list of the delegation per municipality/city to the Curriculum and Implementation Division (CID) c/o EPS -1 in EPP/TLE/TVL two (2) weeks before the contest scheduled.
5. The official list of delegation per event for each municipality both public elementary and secondary schools listed down as follows. Private secondary schools may submit separate list of delegation using the same format.

B. Skills Exhibition Entries at the Division Level

1. Based on the specific guidelines of each event, the school/municipality shall conduct a preliminary screening or selection process to ensure the quality of all entries at the division level.

C. Division Level Awards

1. Only the top three (3) division winners of each event in the different skills exhibitions shall be declared. However, should there be no qualified winner based on the criteria and as recommended by the board of judges, no winner shall be declared.
2. The top 3 winners per event shall each receive a division certificate of recognition and a medal; and
3. The teacher/coach of the top 3 winners shall each receive a division certificate of recognition.

D. General Orientation and Briefing

1. A general orientation of all head of delegations or representatives per school/municipality regarding the events of the different skills exhibition shall be conducted one (1) week before the contest.
2. All clarifications, issues and concerns regarding the Division Festival of Talents (Technolympics) contest shall be addressed during the orientation. Any concerns raised during the actual skills competition shall not be entertained unless they are valid and necessary.
3. A day before the skills exhibition proper, coaches/trainers of each event will have a briefing with the event administrator/facilitators/coordinators/focal person on the mechanics and other details of the specific skills exhibition. The venue of the orientation will be announced during the registration of official participants.
4. Participants are encouraged to visit the venue of the event a day before the actual skills exhibition for familiarization.

E. Mechanics for Judging the Skills Exhibition

1. The products and performances of participants in all events shall be judged by three (3 members of the board of judges composed of experts and practitioners;
2. The score of the three judges in any event shall be computed to determine the AVERAGE SCORE of each participant. The average score shall be the basis for ranking the products/performances of participants to determine the top 3 winners;
3. The tabulation, consolidation, and review of all results shall be done by a committee composed of three (3) Public School Division Supervisors, chair of the board of judges, and two (2) representatives from the host school.
4. The final results shall be reviewed by the members of the board of judges before they affix their signatures on the summary sheet;
5. The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.

2. Skills Exhibition Proper

- 2.1. The event administrators and their secretaries, technical committee and judges, should be in the venue sixty (60) minutes ahead of the event schedule.
- 2.2 Event, materials, supplies, tools, equipment and other things needed at the venue will be made ready by the event administrators an hour before the event schedule.
- 2.3 All participants should be at the designated venue, thirty (30) minutes before the event starts. Late participants without valid reasons shall be disqualified.
- 2.4 The participants will draw lots to determine their respective places and set up food and materials at their assigned places. Setting up of their extension cords, equipment, and tools should be done during the time the event begin.
- 2.5 The briefing of participants will be done fifteen (15) minutes before the scheduled event.
- 2.6 The event secretary will give the signal for the event to begin. Once the event has started, the coaches, teachers and delegates are no longer allowed to talk to the participants to allow them to fully concentrate on their work.
- 2.7 Only the event administrator, secretary, technical staff, judges, official photographer, and participants are allowed in the venue.
- 2.8 No questions shall be entertained during the contest proper except clarifications and point of order. All clarifications and points of order shall be raised with the event administrator.
- 2.9 Should there be any irregularities found during the event, the event administrator, in consultation of the specific skill exhibition, if justified, and refer the matter to the attention of the Technical and Evaluation Committee for appropriate action.
- 2.10 Barrowing of materials, tools, and supplies during the event is not allowed.
- 2.11 The working area should be cleaned immediately after every event.
- 2.12 All output shall be endorsed to the Secretariat by the event administrator.
- 2.13 All endorsed output shall be displayed throughout the duration of the event.

3. Tools and Materials to Bring

- 3.1 All contestants are required to bring their own contest materials, supplies, tools, equipment and other things needed in the contest as reflective in the contest packages.
- 3.2 All contestant are required to bring their own Personal Protective Equipment
- 3.3 Refer to the respective Contest Package for the list of materials, tools, equipment and other supplies that need to be brought.

4. Bazaar Exhibit

- 4.1 All participating Unit (North Unit, South Unit, West Unit, East Unit) are required to display their best products and services (performances) two days before the 2017 Division Technolympics Opening Program. However, the division will choose two entries (one entry for product and one entry for service) to participate in the search for the most enterprising award. Each unit shall assign 2 TLE/TVL& 2 EPP students / pupils who are not participating in the skills exhibition to market their products/services within the exhibit booth area;
- 4.2 All products/services displayed in the bazaar that are produced or rendered by the EPP, TLE and TVL pupils/students as certified by the school head shall be displayed in the bazaar;
- 4.3 The point earned in the bazaar exhibit shall be included in the computation of overall Division Record Holders.

5. Criteria for Judging

5.1 The criteria for judging the Bazaar Exhibits – the Most Enterprising Award shall be based on the following:
