We are pleased to inform you that the Department of Science and Technology - Philippine Nuclear Research Institute (DOST-PNRI) will spearhead the celebration of the 45th Atomic Energy Week (AEW) on 4-7 December 2017 with the theme "**Nuclear Science and Technology for the People**". One of the highlights of the 45th AEW is the 2017 Philippine Nuclear Science Quiz (PNSQ), a national quiz bee competition for junior high school students.

PNSQ is a quiz bee competition intended to be an avenue to develop Filipino students' awareness and appreciation of nuclear science and technology, and to promote the industry in the country. The competition is open to all public and private secondary schools in the Philippines. The competition is divided into two levels - Regional Level and National Level. Only the top two winners in the Regional level are qualified to compete in the National Level. A subsidy for travel expenses, airfare, accommodation and lodging shall be given by PNRI to the teams who will compete in the National Level. The subsidy will cover a round-trip ticket from and to home region and one PNSQ venue and a one-time allowance amounting to five thousand pesos only. Pnsq 2017 given upon arrival of the team to the PNSQ venue. Grand Prizes are as follows:

First Prize	Cash Prize of Php 50,000.00 + Trophy
Second Prize	Cash Prize of Php 40,000.00 + Trophy

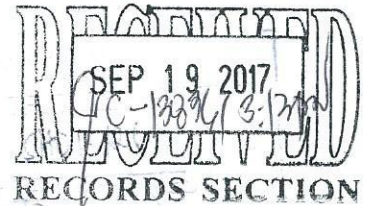

We are pleased to inform you that the Department of Science and Technology – Philippine Nuclear Research Institute (DOST-PNRI) will spearhead the celebration of the **45th Atomic Energy Week (AEW)** on 4–7 December 2017 with the theme **“Nuclear Science and Technology for the People”**. One of the highlights of the 45th AEW is the **2017 Philippine Nuclear Science Quiz (PNSQ)**, a national quiz bee competition for junior high school students.

PNSQ is a quiz bee competition expected to provide an avenue to develop Filipino students' awareness and appreciation of the nuclear science and technology field and its potential role in uplifting the quality of living in the country. The competition is open to all public and private secondary schools in the Philippines. The competition is divided into two levels – (1) Regional Level and (2) National Level. Only the top two winners in the Regional level are qualified to compete in the National Level. A subsidy for travel expenses (airfare, accommodation and lodging) shall be given by PNRI to the teams who will compete in the National Level. The subsidy will cover – (1) roundtrip ticket from and to home region and the PNSQ venue and (2) a one-time allowance amounting to five thousand pesos only (Php 5000) given upon arrival of the team to the PNSQ venue. 
