

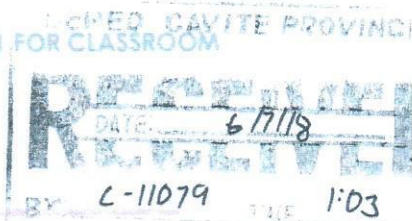

SUBJECT: SUBMISSION OF LIST OF PARTICIPANTS TO GURO21 FOR CLASSROOM TEACHERS

1. The Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization Regional Center for Educational Innovation and Technology (SEAMEO INNOTECH) in partnership with DepEd Region IV-A (CALABARZON) invites participants to attend the Guro21 for Classroom Teachers.
2. The course known as GURO21 or Gearing Up Responsible and Outstanding teachers in Southeast Asia for the 21st Century enable the participants to:
 - a. equip themselves with the knowledge, skills, attitudes, and values (KSAVs) required of 21st century teachers that they can pass on to their students to help them face the challenges of 21st century; and
 - b. develop and enhance their facilitating skills to effectively play their role as teachers in the 21st century.
3. The Participants to this activity are Classroom teachers:
 - a. whose School Heads are graduates of TEACH-XCELS or those who will be recommended by the School Heads / SDO;
 - b. who are preferably not more than 50 years of age;
 - c. who are computer literate and have easy access to internet connection (required to enable participation in the online course);
 - d. who are able to understand, speak, and write in the English language;
 - e. who are able and willing to utilize course lessons, and share them with other teachers and their school heads; and
 - f. with minimum of 3-years in the service.
4. The total cost of this program is Php 7,000.00 per participant which covers registration fee, costs of meals / snacks to be served during the face-to-face portions of the course which can be charged against MOOE / Local Fund subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations, as well as transportation costs of the participants to and from the training venue.

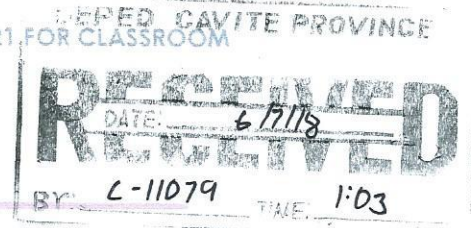
