1. Pursuant to Dep. Ed. Order #26 s. 1997 on Institutionalization of SPED Program in all schools and to strengthen Inclusive Education, the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) under Project Kalinga will conduct a division wide Sign Language for all schools with SPED Center in every municipality starting this month of September onwards.
2. This activity aims to:
 - a. Equip all the regular teachers, SPED teachers, and students with basic sign language skills.
 - b. Ensure that all teachers and students know how to communicate to our LSEN
 - c. Strengthen sign language in an inclusive school environment
