Organizational Profile



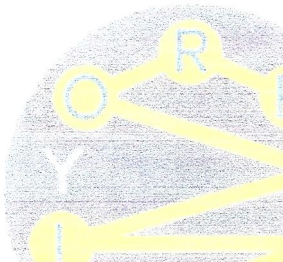

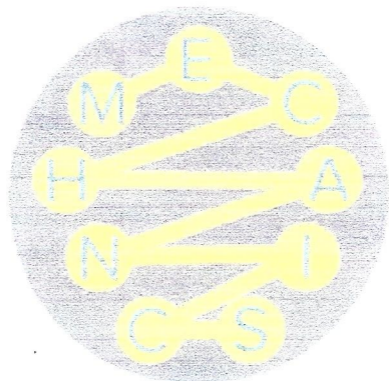

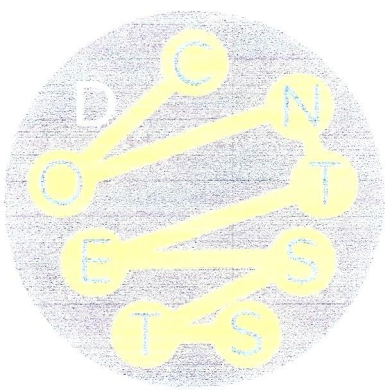
