GENERAL MECHANICS

- (1) Open to all Senior High Schools in the province of Cavite offering Academic track Science, Mathematics, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) strand and/or Technology, Vocational and Livelihood (TVL) track IT strand.
- (2) Participants must be currently enrolled as SHS students (Grade 11 or Grade 12) under the STEM or TVL strand with completed research/investigatory project under the following categories:
 - Biodiversity and Environment
 - Community and Health
 - Math and IT innovations
 - Product development
- (3) Participating schools may send the abstract (not more than 250 words) of all their qualified research output or investigatory projects on or before 22 February 2019 to the Organizing Committee.
- (4) Accepted research papers or investigatory projects for oral or poster presentation will be announced on 28 February 2019.
- (5) A registration fee of P500.00 per accepted paper shall be collected from the participants to cover the souvenir program and materials, certificates, and snacks for the presenter and the adviser.
- (6) Best research output or investigatory projects per category will be selected and will receive cash prizes and certificates for the group, medal for the presenter, and plaque for the school.
