111. SPECIFIC GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS

PRE-SCHOOL

NURSERY RHYME RECITATION

- 1. Each group should be composed of a minimum of 5 and maximum of 10 members.
- 2. The group may choose their nursery rhyme piece.
- 3. There will be two (2) groups: English and Filipino nursery rhymes.
- 4. Each school may send 1 group per entry.
- 5. Each nursery rhyme recital must not exceed five (5) minutes. This includes the entrance and exit.
- 6. The music should be saved in a USB. It should be properly labelled with the participant's name and must be submitted before the competition starts. The USB should contain only the music that the participant will use and no other files.
- 7. Each team are encouraged to wear costumes and provide their own props.
- 8. The winners will be chosen based on the following:

STORY TELLING

- 1. The participant may choose his/ her story piece. It should be related to the theme.
- 2. There will be two (2) groups: English and Filipino stories.
- 3. Each school may send up to three (3) participants per group.
- 4. The story telling must not exceed five (5) minutes. This includes the entrance and exit.
- 5. Costumes and props of each participant are encouraged but not required.
- 6. The winners will be chosen based on the following:

POEM READING

- 1. The participant may choose his/ her poem. It should be related to the theme.
- 2. There will be two (2) groups: English and Filipino poems.
- 3. Each school may send up to three (3) participants per group.
- 4. Each poem reading must not exceed five (5) minutes. This includes the entrance and exit.
- 5. The winners will be chosen based on the following criteria:

- 1. Each group should be composed of a minimum of 6 and maximum of 12 members.
- 2. There will be two (2) groups: English and Filipino .
- 3. The group may choose their own piece relevant to the theme.
- 4. Each school may have one (1) group per entry.
- 5. The performance should not exceed 8 minutes including entrance and exit. It should be related to the theme.
- 6. Costumes and props of each participant are highly encouraged. It must be provided by the participants.
- 7. The winners will be chosen by the following:



STORY TELLING

- 4. The story telling should not exceed five (5) minutes. This includes entrance and exit.
- 5. Costumes and props are encouraged but <u>not</u> required.
- 6. The winners will be chosen based on the following:

- The performance should not exceed 8 minutes including entrance and exit. It should be related to the theme.
- 6. Costumes and props are highly encouraged. It must be provided by the participants.

- 5. Costumes and props of each participant are highly encouraged. It must be provided by the participants.
- 6. The winners will be chosen based on the following:

- 1. Each participant will be given 1.5 hours to finish the poster using the theme: "Developing Excellence and Values among 21st Century Learners."
- 2. Each school may send up to three (3) participants.
- The participants must bring the following on March 2, 2019:
 1pc 1/8 Illustration Board
 1box Oil Pastel/Craypas and other art materials needed for the poster making
- 4. The winners will be chosen based on the following:

Note:

- 1. The Board of Judges will identify the winners per category per criteria.
- 2. For the story telling, sabayang pagbigkas, declamation, and poem reading, kindly email the piece to the organizers on or before 22 February 2019. This will be printed and be given to the judges.
- 3. Teachers/ coaches and parents are not allowed to mingle with the contestants during the contest proper.
- 4. The participants are allowed to have only one (1) companion during the event.
- 5. Announcements of winners and giving of awards will be right after the judges have computed the final scores.
- 6. The decision of the judges are final.
