

# ESTADISTIKA 2019

An Invitational Statistics Quiz, Essay Writing, Poster Making and Photo Contest

ESTADISTIKA is an Invitational Statistics Quiz, Essay Writing, Poster Making and Photo Confest for Highschool students spearheaded by the UPLB Statistical Society. If primarily aims to instill the value of Statistics among highschool students and to promote excellence in Statistics among the youth It also represents an avenue for schools to engage in friendly competition while showing competency in retaining and applying knowledge and skills gleaned from their

QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS
All bonafide Grade 7 to 12 students enrolled during the current term may join this contest. Upon registration, student participants are required to present their student ID or any proof of enrollment for the current term. The coach and student participants are also required to enhant a 2×2 ID nature.

Each participating school can send at most 3 teams and all participating teams shall have 3 members each. A team may be composed of members that are of the same grade level or different grade level.

All participating teams are required to pay a non-refundable registration fee amounting to 1000 pesos (cash only) on the actual date of competition. The registration fee includes an event kit for the student participants.

# CONFIRMATION OF PARTICIPATION

To confirm the school's participation in ESTADISTIKA 2019, the coach must accomplish the entry forms and have it signed by the school principal or administrator.

Entry forms must be submitted via personal delivery, courier service, postal mail, electronic mail or hand-delivery through any certified UPLB Statistical Society member:

UPLB Statistical Society will confirm recognition of entry forms via telephone call, electronic mail, or text message.

#### COVERAGE

All questions that will be asked during ESTADISTIKA 2019 will be taken from the field of Elementary Statistics, applications of the said area and statistics-related trivia questions based on the theme.

## **ELIMINATION ROUND**

The ELIMINATION ROUND shall be held offstage and shall take on the form of a written exam.

All questions for this round shall be of multiple-choice type.

The exam-competition shall last exactly for one (1) hour.

Participating students are requested to bring their own scientific calculator. Programmable calculators are not allowed. Only calculators found on this link will be allowed to be used by the contestants: http://bit.ly/2xqGSEM

Answer sheets will be provided. Participants are not allowed to bring scratch papers. However, the exam questionnaires can be used as scratch paper.

Any form of cheating is not allowed. Team(s) with member(s) caught cheating shall automatically be disqualified

**Contestants who arrived late** may take the exam, but no time extension will be given.

# Manner of Scoring and Correction

Each question item shall merit 2 **points**.

Each contestant shall have an individual contestant shall have an individual contestant.

Each contestant shall have an individual score. The score of each team member will be added to get the overall team score.

The fifteen (15) teams in the ELIMINATION ROUND with the highest team score shall qualify to the EXHIBITION ROUND.

Qualifying teams shall be announced at the start of the EXHIBITION ROUND.

In case of a tie for the fifteenth (15th) place, all teams vying for that place will automatically qualify to the EXHIBITION ROUND.

In case of a tie for the top scoring individual, a tiebreaker shall be held before the Exhibition Round. Coaches will be informed immediately and another written exam shall be done until the tie is broken.

### EXHIBITION ROUND

The EXHIBITION ROUND shall be held off-stage and shall be a quiz-bee type of competition.

Each team will start from zero point.

### General Mechanics

The competition is divided into three (3) phases: **Easy, Average**, and **Difficult** Phases.

There will be overall thirty-one (31) questions. The table below shows the number of questions per round.

A trivia question will be asked after the first question, after the middle question (after the 5th question in the easy phase, after the 4th question in the average phase and after the 3rd question in the difficult phase) and after the last question in the three phases. Only the team(s) who answer(s) correctly in the operational question before the exhibition trivia question.

Questions in any given phase may be of objective or free-response type.

The time allotted for each question will vary according to the difficulty of the question. For the easy round, the contestants will be given ten (10) seconds to answer each question. Thirty (30) seconds will be allotted for average questions and sixty (60) to ninety (90) seconds will be allotted for difficult questions.

Each question shall be **read twice**. Each team shall have a proctor who will provide the answer sheets and the scratch papers. They are also designated to collect the answer sheets after the time limit of each question.

Answers in the computational form are not allowed (e.g. 3! should be written as 6). Final answers in fractional form should be expressed in the lowest term.

Intermediate values should not be rounded off. Failure to do so will render a wrong answer.

In between phases, there will be a **ten-minute** lull for the update of the scores. At the end of the round, the cumulative score of each team will be computed.

The top four (4) teams in the EXHIBITION ROUND based on their cumulative team scores during the Easy, Average, and Difficult Phases shall qualify for the FINAL ROUND. Qualifying teams shall be announced before the start of the Final Round.

In case of a tie for the Fourth (4th) place, a tiebreaker question will immediately ensue and will be "sudden death" in nature.

The first team to gain a positive advantage in score over the others will be declared the victor of the tie and will qualify to the Final Round.

### FINAL ROUND

The Final Round shall be held on-stage and shall be a **board work-problem solving** type of competition.

Finalists will be assigned to write on a white board before the live audience on-stage, which will act as their solving area.

All the qualifying teams are required to present their solutions completely, neatly, and

orderly. **Incomplete and wrong solutions will** render a wrong answer. The members of the team are required to box their final answer.

Just before reading the question, each team will be given their own copy of the question concealed inside an envelope.

All questions will immediately proceed and will be **sudden death/knock-out** in nature. A maximum of **30 to 90 seconds** will be given to the finalists to answer each problem.

The teams will only be allowed to write on he board after the first reading. Failure to follow this will disqualify the team from mswering the question. The time allotted will start after the second reading.

Answers in the computational form are not allowed (e.g. 3! should be written as 6). Final answers in fractional form should be expressed in the lowest term.

Intermediate values should not be rounded off. Failure to do so will render a wrong answer.

### Sudden death/ Knock-out General Procedure:

Case 1: All teams got the correct answer

- All teams shall proceed to the next question.
   Case 2: Three teams got the correct answer
   All three teams shall proceed to the next
- All three teams shall proceed to the next question. The team who got a wrong answer will automatically be eliminated (apply general procedure).
- Case 3: Two teams got the correct answer

  The two teams who got the correct answer
- The two teams who got the correct answer shall proceed to the next question and shall compete for the first place. The losing team shall take the second place. On the other hand, the remaining two other teams will be given another question(s) to compete for the third place (apply general procedure).

**Case 4:** Only one team got the correct answer

The team who got the correct answer will automatically be declared as the champion. The remaining three teams will compete for the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>nd</sup> place (apply general procedure).

vill Case 5: No team got the correct answer the - Another question will be given (apply general procedure).

The *lone* standing team who gave the last correct answer will be declared as the **Grand Champion**. The second from the last team who answered correctly will be hailed as the **First Runner-up Winner** while the third from the last that had a positive advantage will be proclaimed as the **Second Runner-up Winner**.

## PROTEST MECHANICS

Only members of the team or their coach/adviser can raise a protest to be forwarded to the Board of Judges.

During the protest, the participant has the privilege of consulting any reference, provided they are relevant to the subject of the protest.

Protests regarding a question will be tackled only before the next question is read. No complaints on a previous question shall be entertained once the quizmaster starts reading the next question.

The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable.

# QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

All bonafide Grade 7 to 12 students enrolled during the current term may join this contest. Upon registration, student participants are required to present their **student ID or any proof of enrollment** for the current term. The coach and student participants are also required to submit a **2x2 ID picture**.

Each school may send at most three individual entries in the contest. The participant should not be joining any other event in ESTADISTIKA 2019.

A non-refundable registration fee of 350 pesos shall be given on the day of the contest. The registration fee includes an event kit for the student participants.

#### MATERIALS

Writing materials will be provided on the contest proper. Other unnecessary materials such as books, newspapers, journals, gadgets, and the like are not allowed during the contest. Failure to follow this will cause disqualification.

## GENERAL GUIDELINES

Originality of work must always be observed. Plagiarism can be a subject for the contestant's disqualification.

Biases and individual opinions are expected from the contestants. However, discretion will only be allowed as long as it is in the proper context.

The contestant's name must not be written anywhere on the paper. Numbers will be assigned to each contestant, which will be written on the **upper left-hand corner** of the paper.

Maintain a readable handwriting. Essays should be written on only one side of the paper. The contestants may use extra sheets, if needed.

The maximum length of each entry should be 500 words (excluding articles). The word count should be indicated by the contestant on the upper right-hand corner of the paper.

Participants will be given **2 hours** to conceptualize and finish their essays.

The topic, exclusively for the essay-writing contest, will be given during the contest proper. However, the topic is expected to be related to the theme of ESTADISTIKA 2019.
