Greetings from the Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT)!

The DICT, through its training arm, the ICT Literacy and Competency Development (ILCD) Bureau, in partnership with the International Computer Driving License (ICDL) – Asia, will be conducting the 3<sup>rd</sup> ICDL Digital Challenge. The ICDL Digital Challenge have received success and positive response from more than 11, 000 participating students from close to 400 schools in the past two competitions. The competition is open to secondary students ages 13 to 17 years old and to tertiary students ages 18 to 25 years old. The ICT and digital knowledge of participating students will be tested through the Preliminary Round, the National Round, and the Grand Final Round. Participating countries in the Grand Final Round include Bhutan, China, India, Malaysia, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Singapore, Thailand, and Vietnam. Attractive prizes await the winners, including an opportunity to participate in an all-expense-paid Student Exchange Program with ICDL in China, Singapore, Thailand, or Vietnam.

In this light, may we invite your school to participate in the ICDL Digital Challenge 2019. The competition is open to private and public Secondary and Tertiary schools in the country. In the Preliminary Round, students are required to pass an ICDL Module to qualify to the National Round in May 2019. The National Round winners will represent the Philippines in the Grand Final Round in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia in September 2019. 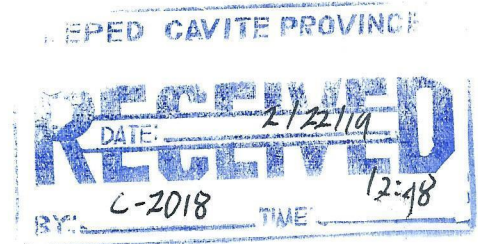

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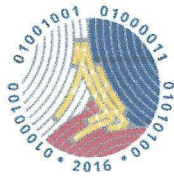

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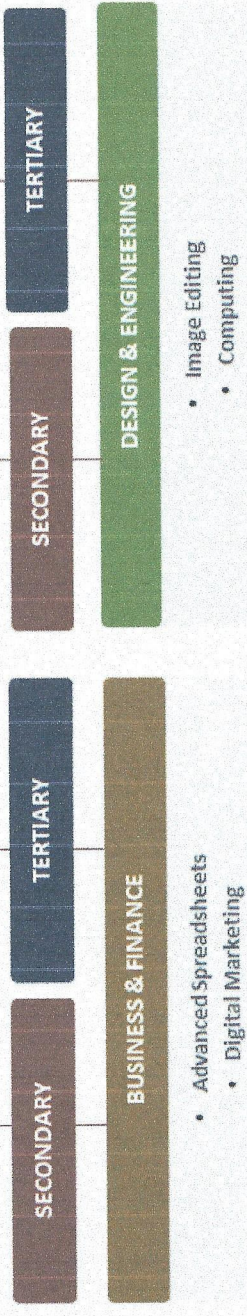

### ROUND 1 (Jan – Apr 2019)

Participating students have to sit for ONE of the following ICDL modules:

- Computer Essentials
- Online Essentials
- Word Processing
- Spreadsheets
- Presentation
- Online Collaboration
- IT Security
- Information Literacy



### ROUND 2 (By 31 May 2019)

Top students selected from each school will qualify for the National Round. Students are to select the track they wish to participate and sit for both modules stated.

### ROUND 3 (Submission on 31<sup>st</sup> July)

- Top 1 students from each category will qualify for the Grand Final Round
- Project brief will be released to all the top students via email on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2019
- Students are required to submit a business report based on the theme stated on the project brief
- Students will present their report and presentation in front of panel judges in Kuala Lumpur in September 2019

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
