Greetings in the name of Teacher Empowerment!

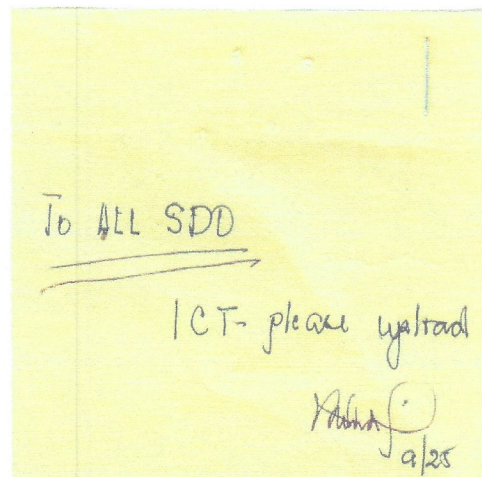
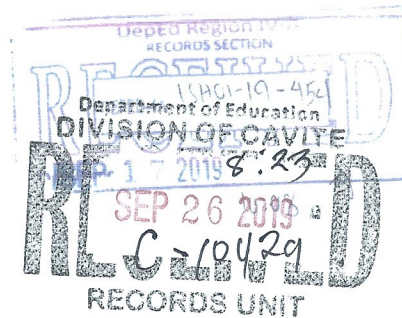
