CONTEST GUIDELINES

- 1. The contests are open only to all the MHCC members from Public and Private High Schools of the different divisions OF CALABARZON. Students who are not a MHCC member are not allowed to join. Otherwise, any participants that is not an MHCC are encouraged to join the MHCC and attend the MHCC weekly Formation in his/her school prior to the contest. The Brother/Sister will check his/her attendance.
- 2. All participants must be properly endorsed by their MHCC animators or school principals through a formal letter addressed to the MHCC.
- 3. NO REGISTRATION FEE
- 4. ALL participants must undergo online registration

CONTEST MECHANICS

- 1. On the Spot Bulletin board design

 - The size of the bulletin board must not be less than 3ft x 5ft.
 - All materials used in the bulletin board must be made from 100% recycled materials with the exemption of cohesive materials.
 - The Bulletin Board must reflect the nature of true Marian Crusader as it expounds the Catholic Faith and can be a material of Catechism to the School.
 - The Bulletin Board must be finished on the spot.
 - There will be allotted time of 30-45minutes in making the bulletin Board design.
 - Each Bulletin Board shall be evaluated according to:

Originality 20%
Artistic Interpretation 30%
Relevance to the Theme30%
Catholic in Nature 20%

- A slogan, which shall serve as the title of the artwork, must be in Filipino and will not exceed 12 words.
- For the purpose of anonymity, the artist's real name, school, and/or other contact details must only appear on the official registration form and in the manifesto, which shall be signed before the start of the contest proper.
- The number and the school which corresponds to the name in the manifesto shall be written on the top portion of the paper provided for the On the Spot Slogan Making
- The use of mobile phones and/or other electronic devices is prohibited during the contest proper.

- Competing groups can be all male, all female, or mixed voices.
- No instruments are allowed whether as textural add-ons or counterpoints.
- Rhythmic body percussion is allowed such as snapping of fingers, clapping of hands and stomping of feet.
- Each COMPETING GROUP is allotted a maximum of eight (5) minutes for the performance. Time immediately starts on the first note and ends when the group finishes its last song. No time warning is given during the competition proper. In the event the group exceeds the allotted time limit, the judges expressly reserve the right to deduct corresponding point/s from the group.
- Competing groups are required to include in their repertoire of original arrangements at least one (1) full MARIAN SONG.
- ONE SONG in the repertoire should be arranged without vocal percussion.
- The competition is also a showcase for inventive and creative adaptation and arrangements of existing or newly composed pieces for a cappella groups. Each group must guarantee EXCLUSIVITY of their arrangements.
- Competing groups shall be required to submit five (5) hard copies of their repertoire's arrangements at least three (7) days before the GRAND MARIAN FESTIVAL.
- Stage movement is highly encouraged.
- The organizers reserve the right to make audio and video recordings of the event. Competition entrants agree to their inclusion in the aforesaid recordings free of any charge/fee. The organizers also reserve the right to publish pictures and names and other related information about the participants in its marketing materials.
- The organizers reserve ownership rights over the recording and video sales and public showing of the event.
- There will be a Grand Prize winner, First (1st) and Second (2nd) runners-up; and an Outstanding arrangement of a MHCC CALABARZON-composed song winner.

5. Marian Dance Fusion

- The group shall consist of 12 members only.
- Any kind of dance is allowed (Hip-hop, Folk, Ethnic, Latin, Contemporary, Jazz, Ballet, Modern) as long as it is stylized and fused that promotes modesty and simplicity in dancing. The focal point of the routine is the theme of 2019 MHCC GRAND MARIAN FESTIVAL.
- Observe authenticity, originality and innovation by not copying any other existing dance group's steps, routines, ideas and concepts. Integrity must be observed in the performance. Be yourself and express your group's diversity with passion, intensity and style.
- Strictly no pyrotechnics of any sort shall be allowed in any presentation
- The attire must be of modest intent (the proposed dress shall be screened by the assigned Brothers and Sisters before the contest.)

- Using pre-recorded music of any kind is strictly prohibited. Such may result to the band's immediate disqualification even if they have performed already.
- The band will perform one (1) for contest proper as contest piece.
- Non-appearance of the band during their turn of performance shall be immediately and automatically disqualified.
- The competing band is required to complete the registration form and submit the registration form before October 11, 2019 of the competition.

- It should contain the theme of the Celebration.
- The entry must be a live action film of any genre.
- The directors and/or production teams are allowed to submit a maximum of two entries.
- Any productions assisted by professional help (film studio or production) will not be accepted.
- Films shall promote values and must not contain material that does not uphold Catholic character and morals.
- The CineMaria is not held responsible for any copyright infringement or misuse of property done by the filmmakers or thet production team. Any entry proven to have plagiarized a material will automatically be disqualified from the competition.
- Entries are pre-screened by a jury composed of the organizers and filmmakers who will be selecting the entries that will be officially part of the festival.
- For the Grand Finals, an official jury of filmmakers and experts will screen the entries. Judging will be based on the following criteria:
 - Relevance to the theme
 - Originality
 - Cinematography
 - Screenplay
 - Editing
 - Sound
 - Overall impact
 - ✓ Performance

- Announcement of finalists will begin on October12, 2019 on mhcc calabarzon Facebook Page.
- The Awarding will be on October 20, 2019, during the 2019 MHCC Grand MARIAN FESTIVAL.
- Submission of entries begins on September 20, 2019. All entries must be submitted on or before October 11, 2019, at LIHM MISSION HOUSE #438 SAMPALOC LAKECOURT SUBDIVISION BRGY. CONCEPCION, SAN PABLO CITY, Laguna. It can also be handed over to the missionary brothers and sisters upon their visit/ apostolate to the participating schools.

- For more than one film submission, director/s and/or production team/s must secure a separate accomplished entry form for each film.
 - 1. The following requirements must be submitted for each entry:
- Accomplished entry form;
