- In line with the implementation of Career Guidance Program in Secondary Schools, the Schools Division Offices are hereby directed to assist and facilitate establishment of CAREER GUIDANCE AND LABOR MARKET INFORMATION CORNERS in all secondary schools.
- 2. As one of the commitments of the Department of Education in the Advocacy Plan for 2018-2020 of the Career Guidance Advocacy Program between DOLE, CHED, DOST, TESDA and PRC, it is stated that DepEd shall establish a Career Advocacy and Labor Market Corner in all basic education institution.
- 3. Career Guidance and Labor Market Information Corners shall include but not limited to the following information: Announcement regarding Career Guidance Program, Forms, Employment Situation, Economic Situation and Job Trends based on Bureau of Local Employment (BLE), Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), Public Employment Service Office (PESO) of the Local Government Units and from the World Economic Forum and other information related to Career Guidance and Labor Market.





- 4. Career Guidance and Labor Market Information Corner shall be put in a conspicuous place inside the school premises.
- 5. Samples of Career Guidance and Labor Market Information can be viewed at http://bit.ly/CGLMICORNER
- 6. PDO I and Career Advocates in schools shall facilitate and assist in the establishment of the CG and LMI Corners.
- 7. It is advised that Career Guidance Program Coordinator and Career Advocates in schools shall frequently update the CG and LMI Corners based on the current trends in labor market and based on the need of the learners.
- 8. Expenses relative to this shall be charged against the School MOOE subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulation.
