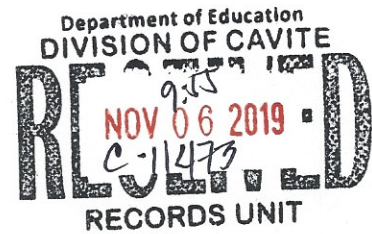

Greetings from Knowledge Channel Foundation Inc.!

In a continuing effort to support our learners in public schools, Knowledge Channel Foundation Inc., in partnership with Unilever, is currently conducting training workshops entitled **"Confidently U"** to a total of 100 schools in Parañaque City, Cavite, Taguig, Manila and Marikina City to help teachers educate the students effectively on personal hygiene, specifically on hair care, facial care, body care and oral care, to build true confidence from within. There were 75 teachers from 20 school beneficiaries from Cavite who participated in the training workshop last September 4, 2019 at Trece Martires City Elementary School (see Appendix for the list of participating schools and teachers).

Included in the training workshops which tackled pertinent learning competencies for Grades 5 to 7 is the provision of 1 (one) external hard drive per school which contains **6 (six) "Confidently U" educational videos and almost 1,000 curriculum-based videos and e-games produced by the Knowledge Channel** which can be used by teachers as instructional tools to improve learning outcomes. Aside from the hard drive, personal hygiene gift packs from Unilever will be distributed to students from Grades 5-7 who watched the **"Confidently U"** videos.

In line with this, may we respectfully request a Memorandum from your office addressed to the school heads of your 20 participating schools on this campaign specifically the following:

1. For the participants of this workshop to cascade the modules turned over to them to all other MAPEH teachers in their respective schools; and for these same teachers have their students view the **"Confidently U"** educational videos at any time of the year;
2. For Grades 5-7 MAPEH teachers have all their students view **"Confidently U"** videos for their MAPEH subject from **November 18 to December 06, 2019**
3. To inform the schools in the attached list that KCFI will visit the school to monitor at least 4 (four) sections from Grades 5-7 between November 18 to 21, 2019 to document class viewings.

For your information, gift packs of various brands from Unilever will be distributed on January 6 to 24, 2019 to grades 5-7 students who watched the **"Confidently U"** videos.

We are also happy to inform you that four (4) of your schools will receive a Gift of Knowledge package consisting of a 40" LED TV set and an additional external hard drive containing all Knowledge Channel programs.
