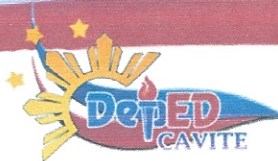

2. The said activity aims to:
- raise awareness on various cases of abuse and violence against children such as trafficking, cyber bullying, child pornography, and juvenile justice;
 - identify and engage youth partners in the advocacy against violence against children
3. Each municipal advocacy campaign shall be attended by **100 SPG/ SSG officers/ members (Grade 6 to senior high school) and advisers from all schools within the district**, the number of representatives from each school to be identified by public schools district supervisors through the District SPG Federation.
4. Selected school venues are expected to prepare chairs, sound system, and other equipment for the conduct of the activity. Food shall be provided for free by the Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office (PSWDO).
