**FOOD SAFETY LEVEL II HAZARD ANALYSIS AND CRITICAL CONTROL POINTS CERTIFICATION TRAINING COURSE FOR SCHOOL HEALTH PERSONNEL AND REFRESHER SEMINAR ON SCHOOL – BASED FEEDING PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION**

1. In reference to RA 10611 2013, declaring the right of every Filipino to promote and protect one's health and instill health consciousness, the Department of Education is committed not only to deliver basic quality education but also to ensure the safety and security of Filipino learners. Hence, the School Health and Nutrition Unit of the Division of Cavite in collaboration with the School Governance and Operation Division is geared towards the enhancement of knowledge and skills on Food Safety Level II Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Points of its School Health and Nutrition Personnel along with the School-based Feeding Program District Coordinators.

2. Furthermore, DepEd Order No. 39, s. 2017 "Operational Guidelines on the Implementation of School-Based Feeding Program" and DepEd Order No. 15, s. 2018 "Supplemental Guidelines on the Implementation of School-Based Feeding Program for Fiscal Year 2018" stated that the Department of Education will continue to implement SBFP nationwide in accordance with the General Appropriation Act (GAA) for the current year and will cover all identified target beneficiaries. The program upholds its objectives in the improvement of classroom attendance of target beneficiaries to more than 85% per year and encourages learners to go to school every day.

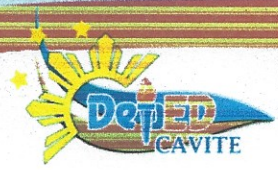
3. The objectives of this activity are as follows:
