

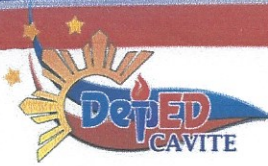

1. This Office thru the Curriculum Implementation Division-Learning Resources Management Section (CID-LRMS) announces the conduct of DIVISION OF CAVITE LEARNING RESOURCES EXPO (DCLRE) on December 10, 2019 at Division of Cavite Covered Court for the exposition and Bulwagang Tanglaw for Opening and Awarding Ceremonies.

3. To facilitate the conduct of the DCLRE, participants are requested to observe the guidelines on how to showcase the various learning resources of their respective municipalities. The DCLRE is open for viewing to all teachers and learners in the division during the event.
4. The participants to this activity are the CID and SGOD Chiefs, Division EPSs, LRMS Supervisor, PDO, Division Librarian, PSDSs, Municipal LR Key administrators, municipal TWG, select school librarians and school property custodians.
5. Coordination Meeting to be attended by each municipal LR coordinators shall be held on November 29, 2019 at Silid Ugnayan, Division of Cavite, Trece Martires City for the planning of the abovementioned activity.
5. Travel expenses and per diem of the participants shall be charged against local funds subject to usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.



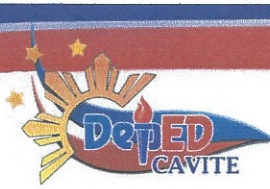

Program : Division of Cavite Learning Resources Expo (DCLRE)

1. Purpose and Scope

Division of Cavite through the Curriculum Implementation Division, Learning Resources Management Section (CID-LRMS) announces the conduct of the DIVISION OF CAVITE LEARNING RESOURCES EXPO (DCLRE) on December 10, 2019 at Division of Cavite Covered Court for the exposition and Bulwagang Tanglaw for Opening and Awarding Ceremonies as a major activity of the division under I-LIKHA Program.

The CLRE aims to collect a rich array of innovative educational learners' and teachers' materials for use in all classrooms like modules, self-learning kits, assessment materials, activity sheets and other nonprint learners' materials in all key stages.

With the availability of these varied supplementary learning resources, it is hoped that teachers can differentiate and engage learners who need enrichment and assistance in learning the skills, values and knowledge in all disciplines using these educational materials.

For purposes of clarity, the following definitions are presented:

1. Educational materials are LRs that adhere to the K to 12 curriculum standard that can be used by both teachers and learners in the deployment of the teaching-learning process.
2. Educational materials are any print or non-print text-based or non text-based, materials, devices, tools, equipment, and other media aligned with the K to 12 curriculum used as primary bases or as supplement to teaching and learning processes.

Learning Resources (LRs) are any digital or non-digital educational resource with a learning purpose. These resources are designed to be used directly by the learners and /or integrated into teacher-developed lesson plans.

Teaching Resources (LRs) are any educational resource, digital or non-digital that support teachers in curriculum development, delivery, and pedagogy or teacher-trainers in the delivery of professional development programs.

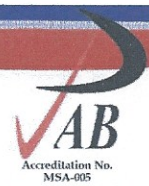
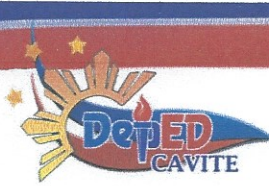

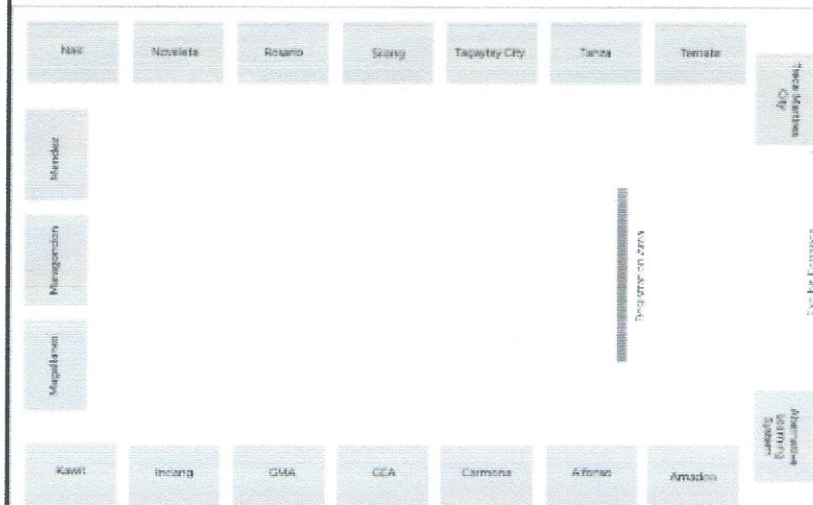


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Exhibit Map for the Division of Cavite Learning Resource Expo 2019
