#### Research Contest Mechanics

- 1. The Research Contest is open to all Junior High School, Senior High School and College students who are actively engaged in research.
- 2. Individual researchers or a group with maximum of five members may participate in the research contest.
- 3. The research method can be qualitative, quantitative or mixed. Poster presentations are also welcome.
- 4. The research paper can be in English or Filipino. It must be recommended by a research adviser.
- 5. The Sibol Organizing Committee will hold an initial screening of the entries. All qualified researchers will be notified through an email containing salient details of the contest.
- 6. Exemplary researchers will receive a certificate.
- 7. The Sibol Organizing Committee expects the research contest participants to have parental consent (when applicable) and accompanied by the research adviser or an adult chaperone during the conference. For every six (6) registered student participants, the registration fee of one (1) coach will be waived.
- 8. Exemplary research papers may be published in the partner journals of Lumina Foundation, namely Asia Pacific Journal of Multidisciplinary Journal and International Journal of Research in Education.
