This refers to the request of Mr. Ramon Suzara, Chief Operating Officer, Philippine Southeast Asian Games Organizing Committee (PHISGOC) to suspend classes for the 30th Southeast Asian (SEA) Games (attached as "Annex A").

The Department of Education (DepEd) supports the Philippines' hosting of the 30th SEA Games and will extend its assistance to the PHISGOC within the limits of our resources, governing laws, and regulations.

In response to their request, we will suspend classes on December 2-6, 2019, in public schools included in the list as attached to their October 23, 2019 letter ("Annex B").

In addition to their request for suspension of classes, we have identified six (6) public schools in Manila, Pasay City, and Pasig City to be used as billeting quarters of two hundred ninety-six (296) drivers during the SEA Games in ("Annex C"). This means that classes shall also be suspended in these schools.

However, with respect to private schools, it is our policy that the recommended suspension of classes is within the discretion of their respective school administrations. As such, we are referring the PHISGOC request to the respective school administrations of those private schools for their action ("Annex D-1 to D-3").

I trust that you would coordinate this matter with the concerned schools division superintendents in your respective jurisdictions. Thank you.




