

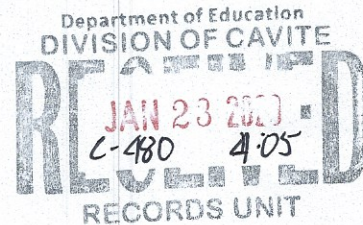

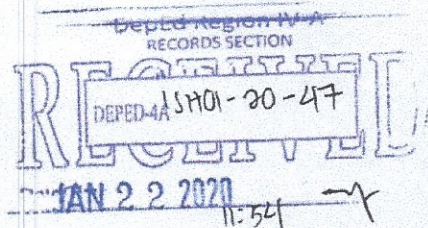

Greetings of Peace!

The Teachers' Dignity Coalition-CALABARZON Teachers' Union (TDC-CALABARZON-TU) will be having a forum on the topic "*Teachers' Right to Self-Organization: The Magna Carta for Teachers and the Public Sector Unionism*" scheduled on January 24, 2020, Friday, 1:00PM to 5:00PM at the Library of Dasmariñas Integrated High School, Dasmariñas City. This is a part of TDC Learning, Advocacy and Consultation (TDC-LAC) Session, an education and capacity building program for the members of the TDC and other interested teachers.

This particular session aims to educate the teachers on their right to self-organization coupled with all its responsibilities. To shed light on the said topic, the TDC-CALABARZON-TU has invited resource speakers. Apart from public sector unionism, the following concerns shall also be discussed:

1. TDC-CALABARZON-TU relief assistance for Batangas;
2. Updates and analysis on the SSL V; and
3. Discussion on 2020 National Budget.

Some 150 teacher-leaders and school heads from CALABARZON region are expected to attend this forum. A voluntary contribution of P100.00 shall be requested from each participant to cover the cost of snacks, documents, certificates and other incidental expenses. *Teachers from Batangas and other "Taal-affected areas" are still welcome to join the session, however since we understand their present condition we do not expect a full attendance.*
