
### IN-SERVICE TRAINING ON BASIC INTERVENTIONS FOR COMMON HEALTH CONCERNS AMONG LEARNERS AND SCHOOL HEALTH PROGRAMS REORIENTATION FOR THE SY 2020 - 2021

- 1. Relative to the results of the 2019 Voice of the Customer (VOC) of Medical Services, gathered from the Clinic Teachers in all the 18 districts of DepEd Cavite Province, majority of them expressed a need for training on basic first aid interventions. Furthermore, with the fast turnover of assigned clinic teachers in schools and to keep them abreast with the current policies, guidelines and directives in relation to Oplan Kalusugan (OK) sa DepEd six flagship programs, a re-orientation to the different school health programs was also viewed as necessary. Thus, this office through the initiative of Medical Unit, shall conduct an in-service training on basic first aid interventions for common school health concerns and re-orientation of school health programs in preparation for its implementation on the coming SY 2020 - 2021. The activity will be facilitated by the assigned division nurses on their respective districts on July 10, 2020, 9:00 am - 12:00 noon through the use of Zoom or Google Meet web applications.
- 2. This in-service training aims to capacitate the clinic teachers on the management of common health problems among their learners. Specifically, it aims to:
  - a. Identify correct and appropriate interventions to common health concerns experienced by learners.
  - b. Develop basic skills in applying first aid interventions.


- c. Become re-oriented on the different school health programs in preparation for its implementation on the coming SY 2020 -2021.
