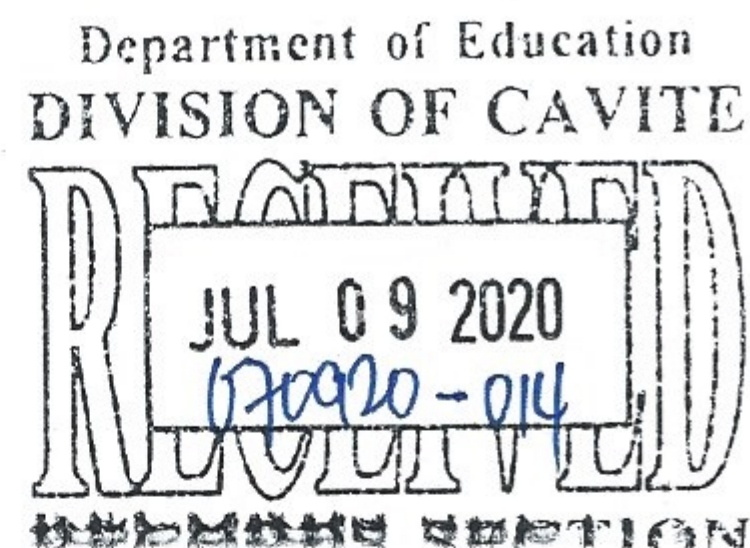

**DRY-RUN OF SCHOOL LEARNING CONTINUITY PLAN**

1. In order to provide guidance to all offices, units, schools, and community learning centers, learners & their parents, and stakeholders, the Department developed a Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan (BE-LCP), a package of education interventions that will respond to basic education challenges brought about by COVID-19.
2. DepEd CALABARZON & our Division have adjusted and align our plans according to the BE-LCP for SY 2020-2021.
3. To thresh out potential problems & to test the effectiveness of our contextualized interventions/activities, this Division shall be conducting **DRY-RUN** of the School Learning Continuity Plan (SLCP) on **July 27-31, 2020**.
4. The following schools will lead the dry-run:
  - a. Felipe Calderon Elementary School – Tanza District
  - b. Aguado Elementary School – Trece Martires City District
  - c. Noveleta National High School – Noveleta District
  - d. General Mariano Alvarez Technical High School – Noveleta District
  - e. Francisco Tolentino Senior High School – Tagaytay District
5. Remaining districts are also encouraged to conduct dry-run on the same week to at least one Learning Area per class per grade level per modality.
6. Soft copy of the modules to be used during the dry-run will be provided by the Curriculum Implementation Division.
7. The Schools Governance and Operations Division (SGOD), together with Learning Area Supervisors will monitor the conduct of the said dry-run.
8. Schools are expected to document the dry-run. **Reports with video and photos** will be submitted to SGOD on **August 4, 2020**.



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9. School Heads and PSDS are enjoined to collaborate with stakeholders to facilitate the smooth flow of the dry-run.
