DRY-RUN OF SCHOOL LEARNING CONTINUITY PLAN

- In order to provide guidance to all offices, units, schools, and community learning centers, learners & their parents, and stakeholders, the Department developed a Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan (BE-LCP), a package of education interventions that will respond to basic education challenges brought about by COVID-19.
- DepEd CALABARZON & our Division have adjusted and align our plans according to the BE-LCP for SY 2020-2021.
- To thresh out potential problems & to test the effectiveness of our contextualized interventions/activities, this Division shall be conducting DRY-RUN of the School Learning Continuity Plan (SLCP) on July 27-31, 2020.
- The following schools will lead the dry-run: 4.
 - Felipe Calderon Elementary School Tanza District
 - Aguado Elementary School Trece Martires City District
 - Noveleta National High School Noveleta District
 - d. General Mariano Alvarez Technical High School Noveleta District
 - Francisco Tolentino Senior High School Tagaytay District
- Remaining districts are also encouraged to conduct dry-run on the same week to at least one Learning Area per class per grade level per modality. 5.
- Soft copy of the modules to be used during the dry-run will be provided by 6. the Curriculum Implementation Division.
- The Schools Governance and Operations Division (SGOD), together with 7. Learning Area Supervisors will monitor the conduct of the said dry-run.
- Schools are expected to document the dry-run. Reports with video and photos will be submitted to SGOD on August 4. 2020.
