The Department of Science and Technology (DOST)—Technology Application and Promotion Institute (TAPI) in partnership with DOST Regional Office IV-A (CALABARZON) will be conducting its first virtual 2021 Regional Invention Contest and Exhibits (RICE) on 04-06 May 2021 with a theme of "Imbensyon at imobasyon para sa kalusugan, kabuhayan, kaayusan at kinabukasan".

RICE is a biennial nationwide activity that recognizes the indispensability of Filipino inventors, students, and professionals in the landscape of national economic development through appropriate platforms especially under the new normal. The invention contest gives encouragement to inventors to showcase their inventive capability through a form of competition for cash incentives, awards, and bragging rights. The regional contest serves as a qualifying round for the national contest, pursuant to Section 4 of the RA 7459 (Inventors and Invention Incentives Act of the Philippines).

The contest is composed of five categories namely (1) Outstanding Invention (Tuklas Award), (2) Outstanding Utility Model (Unlad Award), (3) Outstanding Industrial Design (Banghay Award), (4) Outstanding Creative Research (Likha Award), and (5) Outstanding Student Creative Research (Sibol Award) for high school and college students.

In line with this, we would like to request for a Regional Memorandum or Advisory to encourage the participation of high school students and teachers (researchers and inventors) in this contest.
