- 9. Incidental expenses of the participants relative to their attendance to the Conference shall be charged to local funds, MOOE, canteen funds or school paper funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- Participants from private schools shall make necessary arrangements with their 10. institutions in connection to their participation to the contests.
- 11. It is reiterated that students joining the district and higher-level competitions in journalism be given the rightful, valid and planned considerations in their academic written requirements and performances.
- 12. Service credits shall be given to teachers/school paper advisers for the Journalism Training on weekends.
- To ensure clarity of the mechanics of the competitions, a virtual meeting of the participating school paper advisers shall be held April 22, 2021, 1:00 p.m, meeting link of which shall be given to the concerned personnel.
- Final Working Committees with the EMAAC, CASSPA and CAESPA officers and members shall be announced through an addendum after the total number of participants have been consolidated.
- 15. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.
