**PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION OF THE ADJUSTED BASIC EDUCATION –
LEARNING CONTINUITY PLAN (BE-LCP) FOR SY 2021-2022**

1. The Basic Education-Learning Continuity Plan (BE-LCP) is consistent with the mandate of Section 1, Article XIV of the 1987 Constitution for the state to protect and promote the right of all citizens to quality education and to take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all. Under Section 6, Chapter 1 of Republic Act No. 9155, or the Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001, DepEd is vested with the authority, accountability, and responsibility for ensuring access to, promoting equity in, and improving the quality of basic education.
2. The BE-LCP aims to ensure the health, safety, and well-being of the learners, teachers, and personnel in the time of COVID-19, while finding ways for education to continue amidst the crisis. It has been designed with a legal framework that is responsive to the “new normal,” keeping in mind the constitutional mandate to uphold the right of all citizens to quality education at all times.
3. Anent to this, all schools in the Division are hereby directed to revisit their current BE-LCP for an in-depth review and gap analysis, as basis for adjustment of their BE-LCP for the SY 2021-2022.
