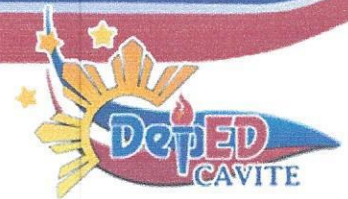
**CALL FOR PAPERS FOR 2ND CAVITE BASIC EDUCATION
RESEARCH CONFERENCE 2017**

1. The Department of Education Schools Division of Cavite Province, in line with the upcoming 2017 International Conference of Basic Education Researchers (ICBER 2017) at the Philippine International Convention Center, Manila on 4-6 December 2017 of the Department of Education, Region IV-A CALABARZON and with reference to its annual research conference, announces its **2nd Cavite Basic Education Research Conference (CBERC 2017)** on October 26-27, 2017.
2. The theme of this year's conference, which also alludes to ICBER's, is "**Research Innovations in Strengthening the Implementation of the Basic Education Research Agenda**". Cognizant of the fervent need to disseminate research findings and share its output, this conference aims to:
 - a. Provide an avenue for research dissemination and a forum for educational researchers to share their initiatives;
 - b. Showcase educational research projects borne from institutional needs and paved towards the improvement of school measures and outcomes; and
 - c. Serve as an opportunity for researchers to benchmark best evidence-based research practices.
3. To wit, this memorandum opens officially its **Call for Papers** for interested researchers with completed basic or action research outputs or full manuscripts accomplished within the past three (3) years (2015-2017) and have not been similarly presented in the division research conference (CRC) or PCBER last year.
4. Teachers, researchers, school heads, and graduate school students are invited to present their paper in this conference. Master teachers, education program supervisors, district supervisors, and educational leaders are enjoined to present their researchers.

5. Submitted abstracts for paper or poster presentations should fall under the following themes:

- Theme 1: Teaching and Learning
- Theme 2: Child Protection
- Theme 3: Human Resource Development
- Theme 4: Governance/School Administration/Leadership/Management
- Theme 5: Disaster Risk Reduction Management
- Theme 6: Inclusive Education
- Theme 7: Gender and Development

6. Abstracts should consist of not more than 250 words following the structured format:
(See Enclosure No.1 for abstract entry format)

- Purpose
- Design/methodology/approach
- Findings
- Research limitations/implications (if applicable)
- Originality/value
- Keywords
- References (not included in the word count)

7. Abstract entries must be submitted electronically as doc. Soft copy files through depedcavite.research@deped.gov.ph together with other proponent(s) details. For submission purposes, the uploaded doc. file should follow the following format "themenumberresearcher'sFirstname_lastname". e.g. theme2Jose_delacruz.doc.

8. The deadline of submission of Abstract entries is until September 22, 2017.

9. Conference details shall be released in a separate memorandum.

Abstract (150 – 250 words)

- 1) **Purpose** [Objectives of the Research]
- 2) **Design/Methodology/ Approach** [How the research was conducted, includes sampling, mode of data collection, the theoretical or subject scope of the paper]
- 3) **Findings** [Result of the research, analysis of data, discussion]
- 4) **Research limitations/Implications** [methodological parameters that can restrict the scope of the research findings and are outside the control of researchers]
- 5) **Originality/Value** [What is new in the research? What is the value of research? Is the research, heuristic or holistic?]
- 6) **Keywords** [Listing of Keywords will facilitate the search for the research; should be italicized]
- 7) **Reference** [not included in the word count]

Full Version of the Research (not exceeding 4, 000 words)

The full paper to be submitted shall be written as a manuscript for journal publication observing APA Style, and has the following components:

- 1) Title
- 2) Introduction
- 3) Brief Review of Literature
- 4) Research Questions
- 5) Scope and Limitations
- 6) Methodology- sampling, data collection, data analysis
- 7) Results and Discussion
- 8) Recommendation- for completed research
- 9) References
